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Notice the three different fonts showing the same Hebrew letter.

Fold on this dotted line.
Glue or tape the two sides together as desired.

Cut on the gray solid lines.

	<p>Sound: T As in <u>T</u>all and <u>T</u>ree</p> <p>Letter Name: Tet</p>
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Quizzing the learner to identify the letter's **sound** is recommended. Knowing the Letter Name is unnecessary for phonetic reading of Hebrew. The Letter Name is included only as a side note.

Note the Baseline and Topline. Help the learner pay attention to which letters have a "descender" that dips below the baseline, or an "ascender" that rises above. **For some letters and fonts the only distinction is where it sits in relation to the baseline.**

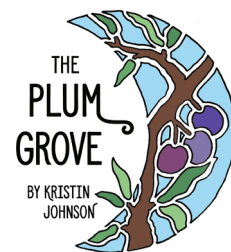
Note that I use "KH/Choke/Cough" to refer to the unique throaty sound of some letters. If you have never heard this sound, have someone pronounce it for you or look for a sound clip online. It is a sound with no exact match in English.

HEBREW VOWELS FLASHCARDS

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Learner Side **Teacher Side**

Cut on the gray solid lines.

Any consonant can be paired with a vowel. The silent letter "alef" is on these cards in gray as the *placeholder consonant*. As the learner is reading the card, they will only say the vowel sound, since this consonant is silent.

Note the Baseline and the Topline. Vowels sit in a few different spots in Hebrew, but mostly they sit underneath consonants, below the baseline. A few vowels have placement exceptions, which you will see on the flashcards.

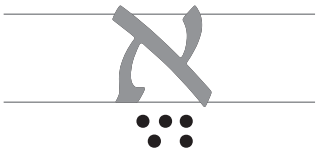

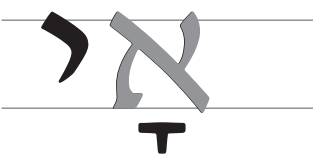
